We also need your Voting Delegate Information sheet and Nomination Sheet at the same time.

There are a number of other forms appended to this newsletter which are also very important to get back to us as soon as possible – we need these details in order to keep the website up to date and also so that we can compile the winter flyer which will advertise all of the upcoming courses for the winter schools.

- School Planning Data Sheet this should be completed and submitted in time for the Fall or Winter flyer creation (whichever is appropriate for your school).
  - Fall Flyer Deadline: August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019
  - Winter Flyer Deadline: December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019
- Historical Data Sheet this should be completed once your school has started and you know how many students are in each class. We need this information in order to fulfill our funding obligations.
  - **Deadline:** February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- Liability Release Form this form is for use by teachers who may be concerned that injuries could be sustained during their class ie: sports, woodworking, crafts with knives ...
- Free Pass Sheet free passes are available to committee members and instructors in order to enable them to attend classes at other schools so that they can expand their own knowledge and potentially teach new classes at their own school. NOTE: this pass is for the annual per student admin fee, not for any additional costs that special courses may incur ie: materials
