Teachers and committee members gather twice a year at Association events to socialize

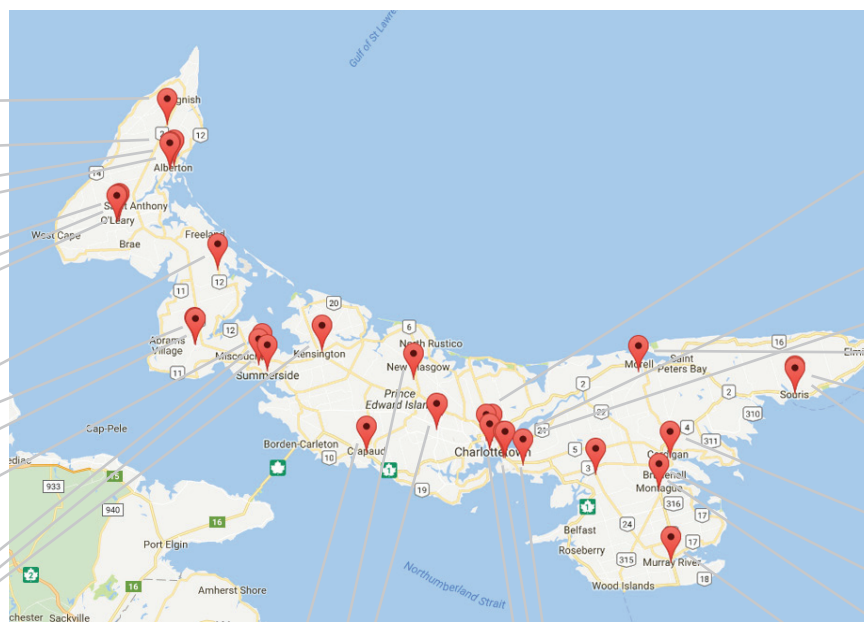

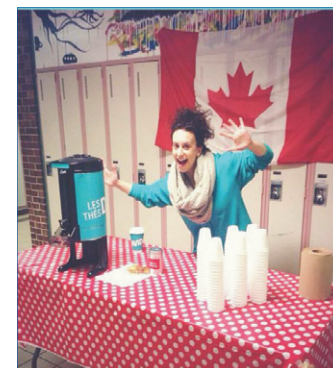

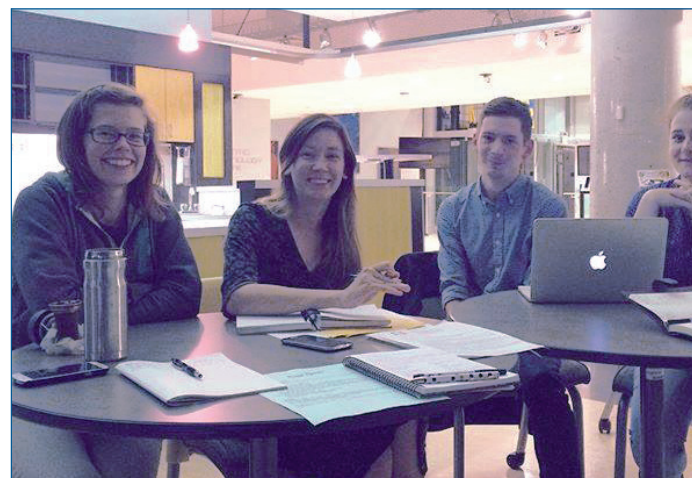
